





The Dondi Green collection uses yarn dyed fabrics through ecological dyeing processes.

This type of dye uses only natural elements such as flowers, leaves, berries and roots allowing to obtain a wide range of colors and fascinating shades.

Through years of studies, 212 different herbs have been analyzed, 65% from Italy and Europe, the rest from Asia and the Americas.

Starting from these herbs, ancient textile dyeing techniques have been re-proposed, from an artisanal scale to an industrial scale, in a modern and ecological key, creating a sustainable, natural, elegant color.

This method allows to control the entire production process thus ensuring the absence of any chemical product.

The natural dye also refuses the use of chemical additives by exploiting natural additives capable of guaranteeing good characteristics of resistance and fastness to washing and light.

By studying a large number of herbs from around the world, exclusive recipes have been developed that use 212 different herbs.

Alcanna, Sandalwood, Henna, Blueberry, Frangula, Walnut, Juniper, Chestnut, Ash, Horsetail, Calendula, Mallow, Altea, Birch, Turmeric, Licorice, Indigofera are just a few.


These herbs allow to obtain the best result: dyes without the use of chemical additives, completely natural, with good characteristics of solidity and reproducibility.




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
